They learnt all about the water cycle and lots of new vocab including collection, evaporation, condensation and precipitation. They also learned about water treatment and how to avoid wasting water. Did you know that each person uses 150 litres of water a day? Some of our Y4 children were also chosen to represent the school at a recent Quad Kidz Athletic competition at Eastbourne Sports Complex. Children took part in a 50m sprint, howler throw, 400m run and the standing long jump. Our Y4 athletes all had a fantastic day, tried their best and were a credit to the school.

#### **Year 5 River Visit**

This half term Y5 enjoyed a visit to Teesmouth and the Transporter Bridge as part of their geography topic about rivers. The children developed their learning on the features of a river and learnt about the course of the River Tees. 
### **Outdoor Classroom Day**

The children are now confident to make emergency calls and to administer some basic first aid.



#### **Mammal Web**

The school had an amazing opportunity to be part of a research project in association with Durham University. Thank you to all the parents who filled out questionnaires, the data has been very useful to the University. This half term Y6 children took part in a workshop about mammals, which involved setting up a camera trap and finding out lots of information about wildlife in Britain. Over the summer the camera trap will allow us to track and take photographs of mammals that enter the wilderness area of our school grounds.

#### Wilderness Schooling



Wilderness Schooling delivers the core curriculum in Maths, Science and English using the outdoors as the classroom resource. Class 11 and 12 worked with a Wilderness Leader to complete poetry inspired by the outdoors, measure area and perimeter using tent



pegs and string, conduct science experiments, cook popcorn and bake bread on the campfire and build insect habitats in the wilderness garden. The children learnt how to treat nature and the wild with respect; we are looking forward to doing more of this style of learning next year.

## Sports Achievement Assembly

We celebrated sport at Northwood in our annual Sports Achievement Assembly this week. Key Stage 2 gymnasts and dancers participated and impressed everyone with their immense talent!
